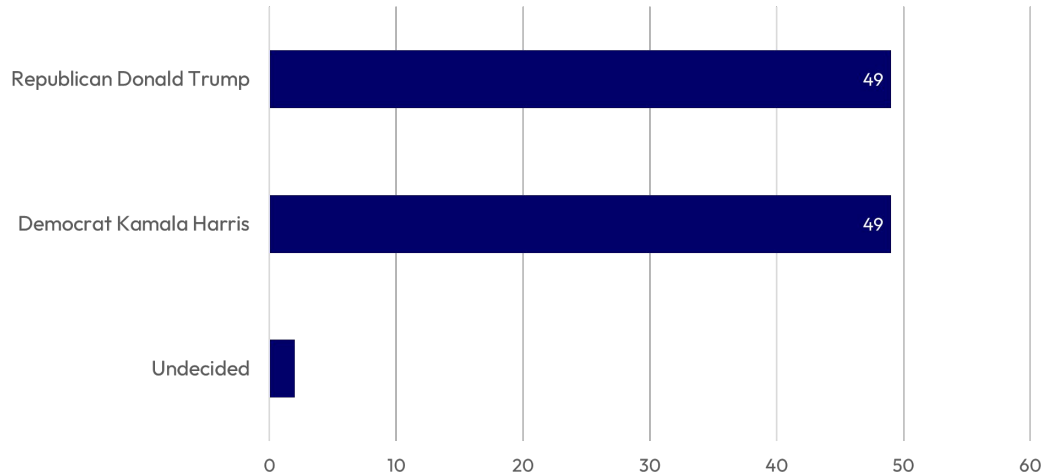

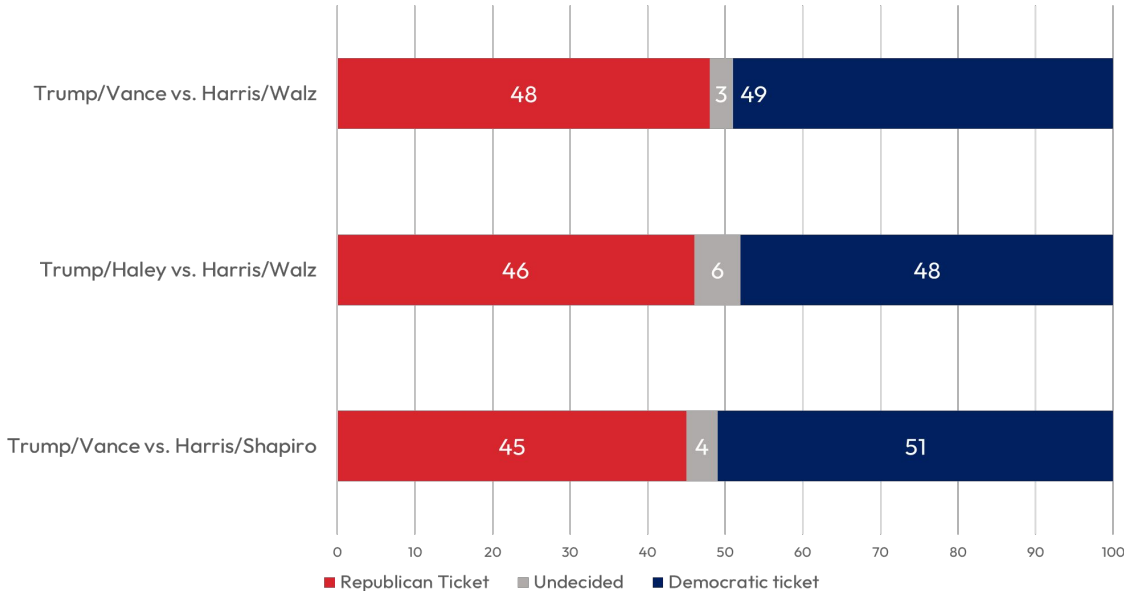

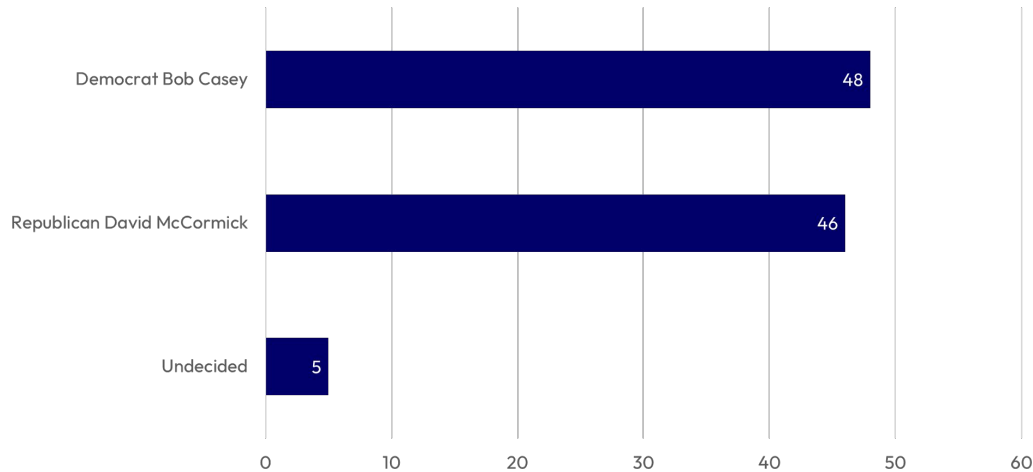

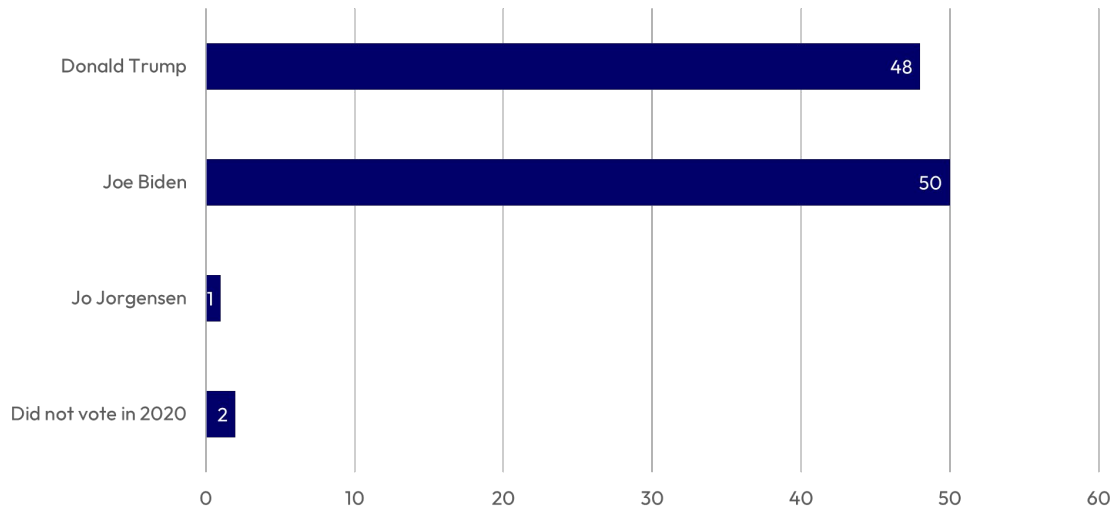
If the November 2024 Election for US Senate were held today, would you vote for the Democrat Bob Casey or Republican David McCormick?

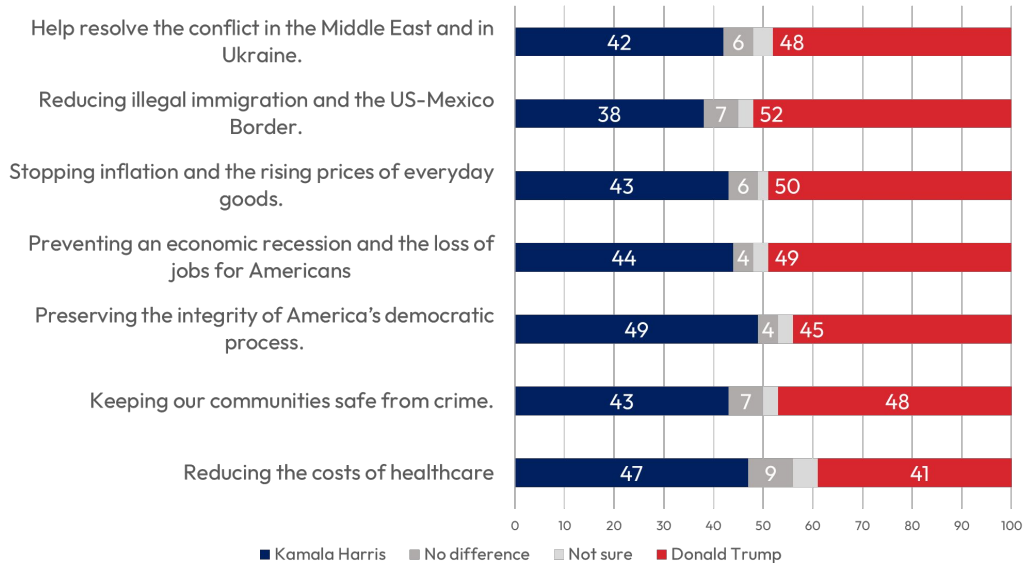
2020 Presidential Vote

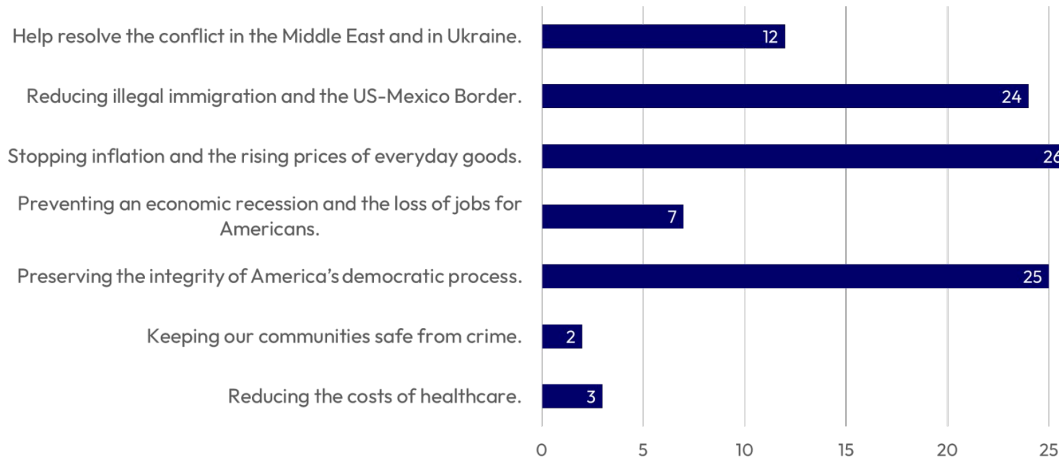

Which of the following outcomes from the following list would be most important when considering who to vote for for president?

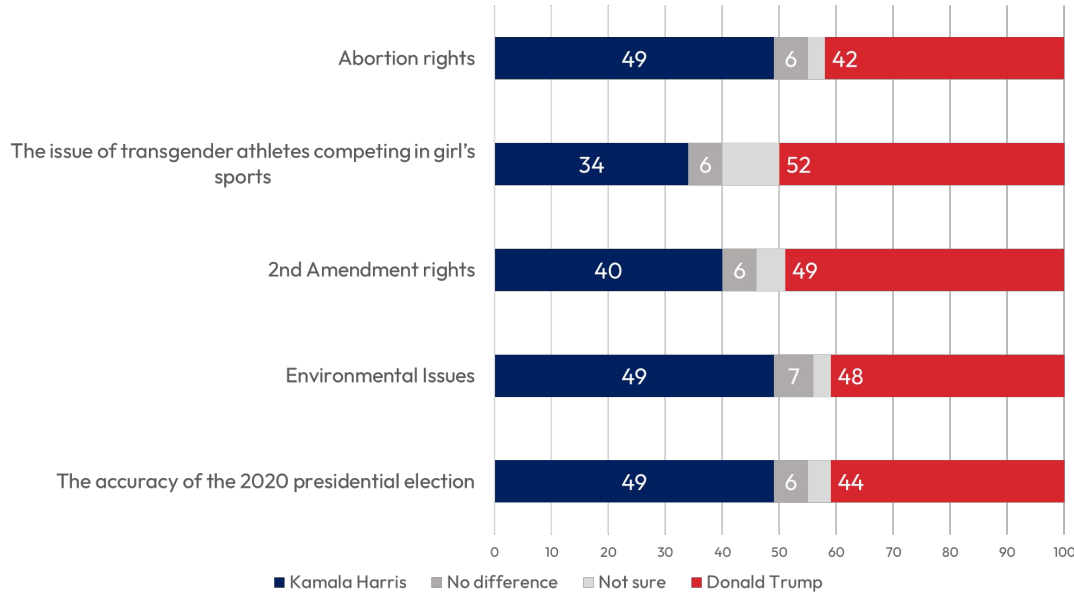

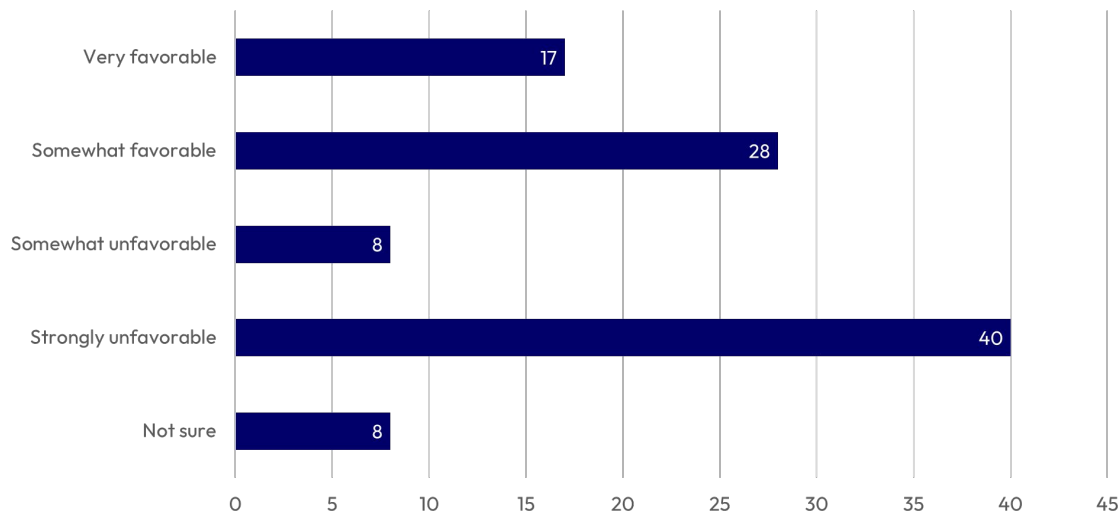

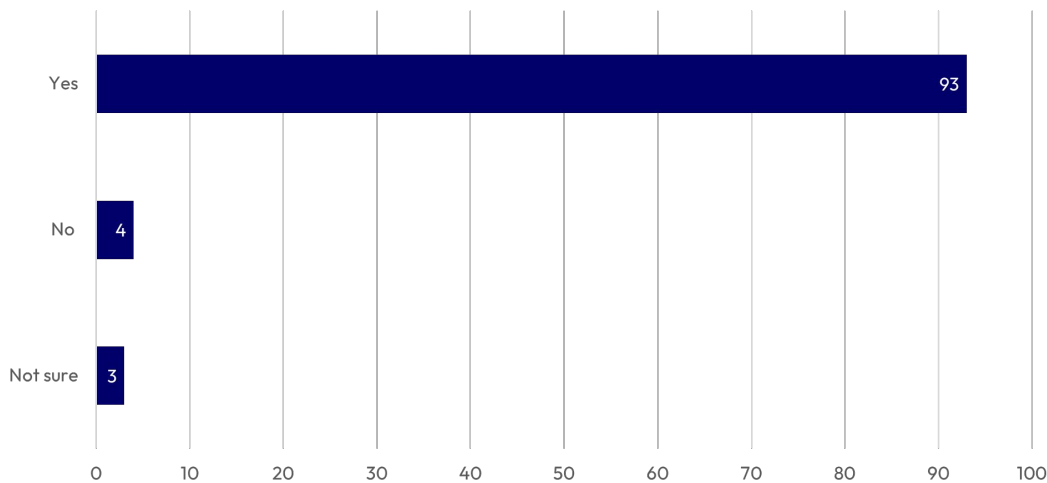
Overall, do you have a favorable or unfavorable opinion of Robert F. Kennedy Jr?

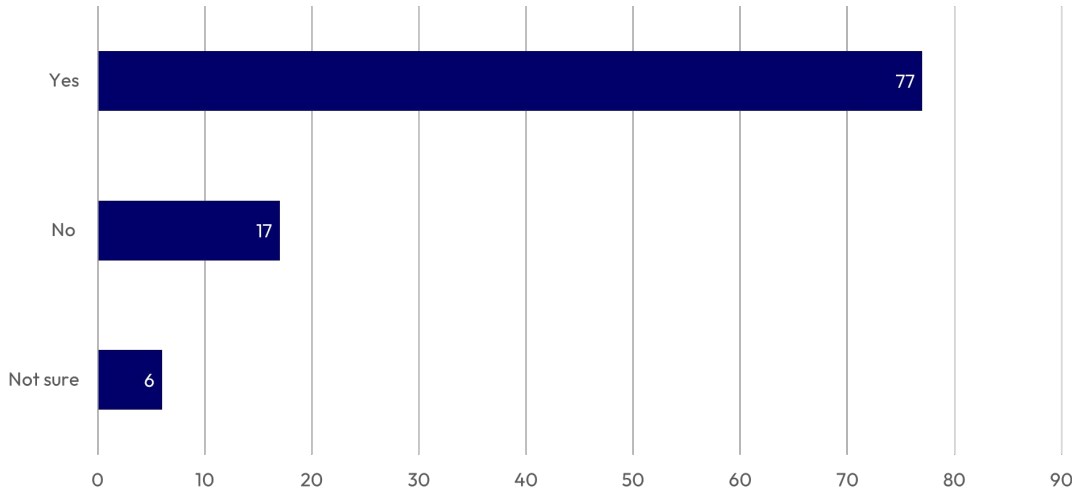

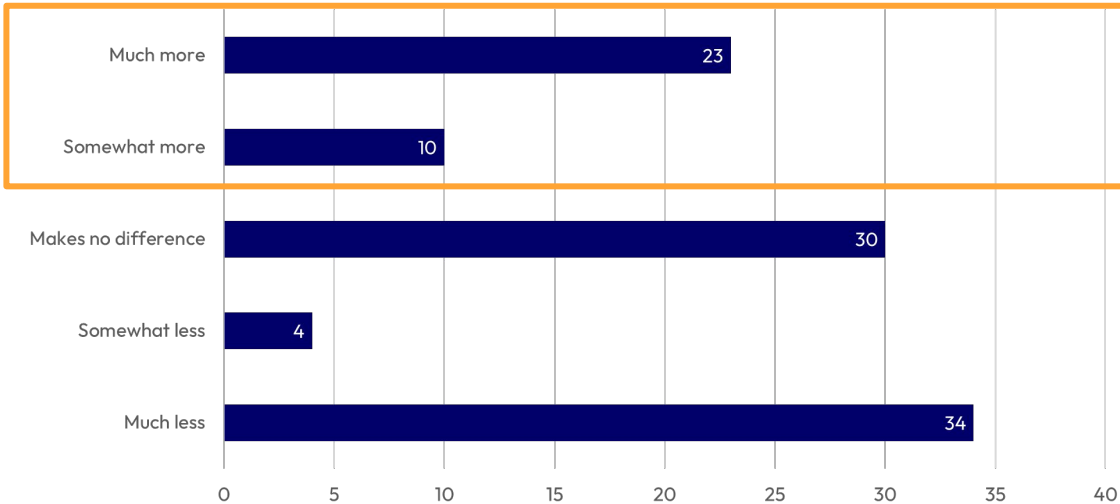
Prior to this survey, were you aware that Trump has announced that he will add Robert F. Kennedy and to serve in his next administration if he is elected?

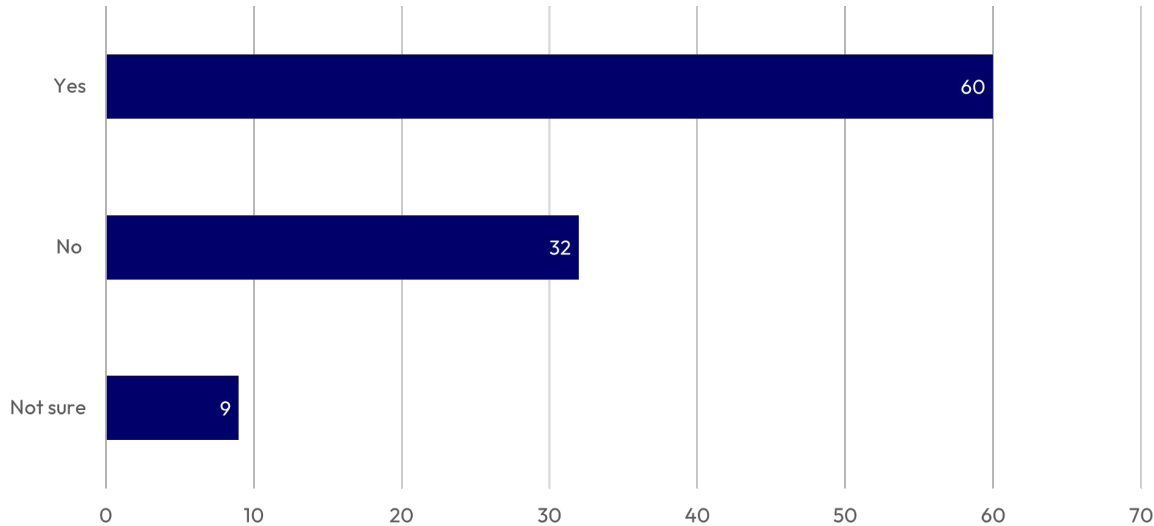

Musk Administration Awareness

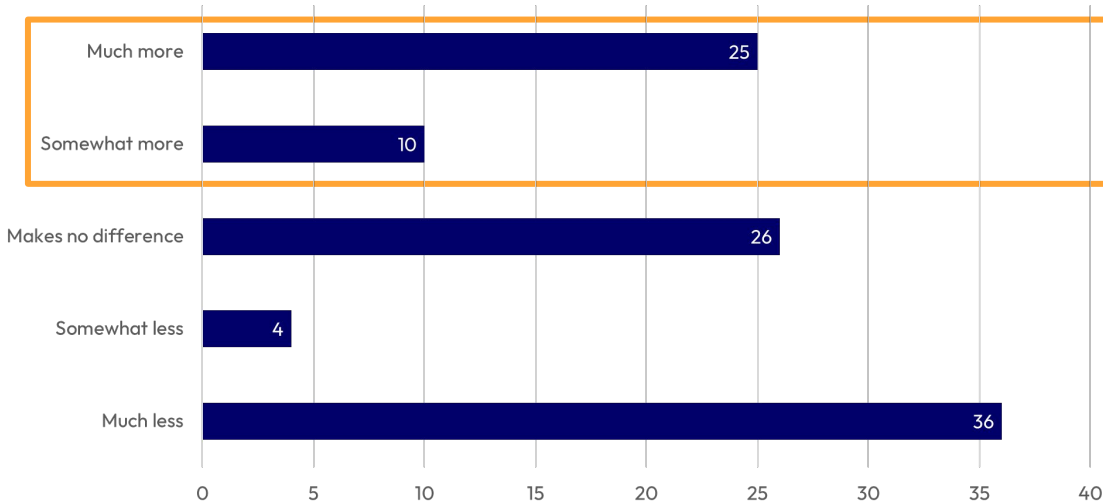

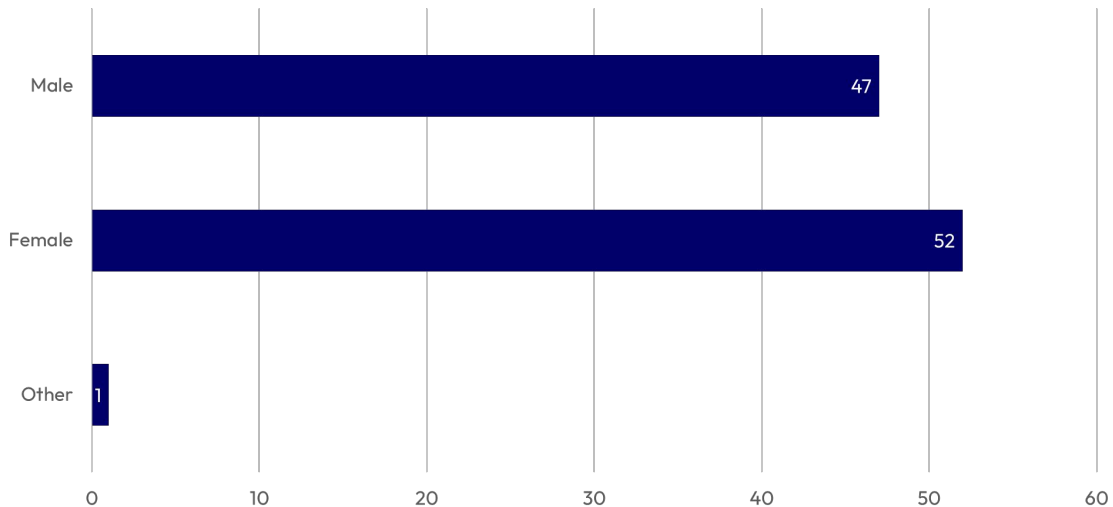
Does the idea of Elon Musk serving on a government efficiency commission make you more or less likely to support Donald Trump in the November election?

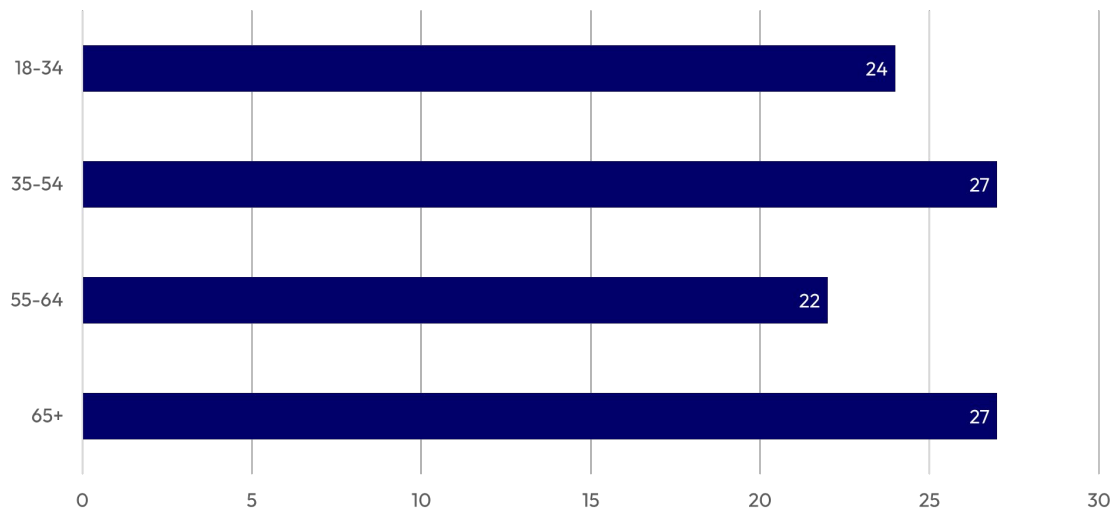

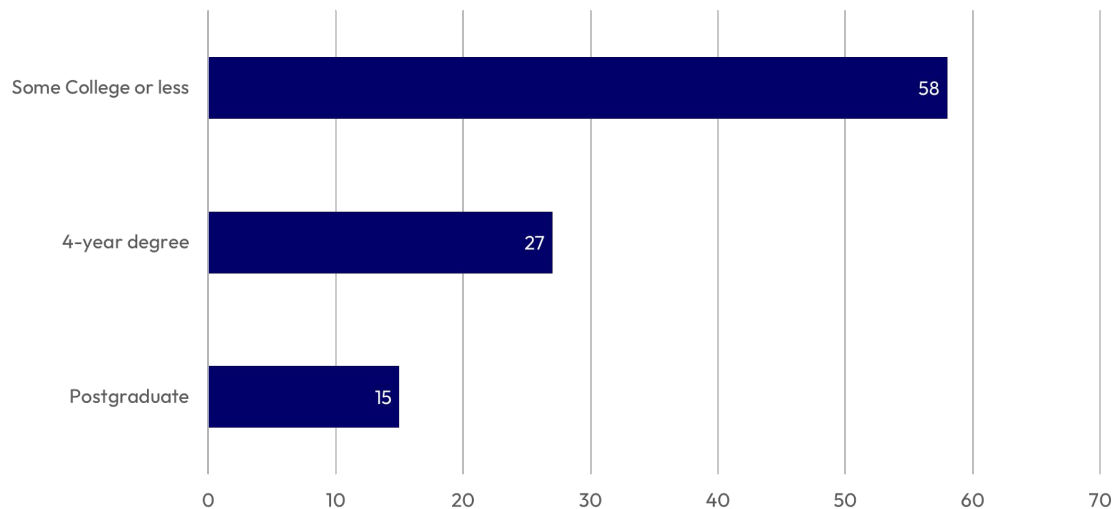
Age

Which of the following is your age range?



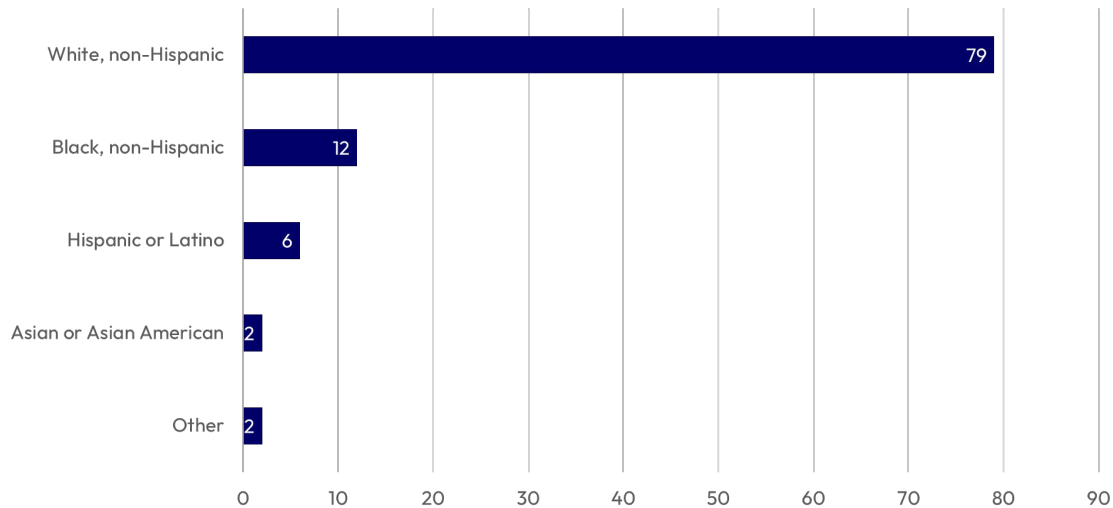

What is the highest level of education you have completed?



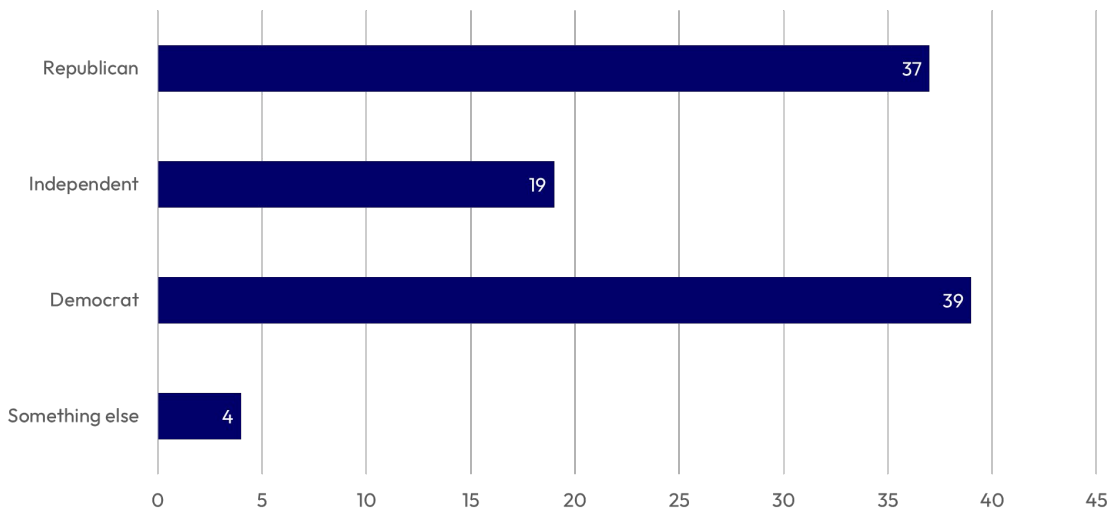

What is your ethnicity?



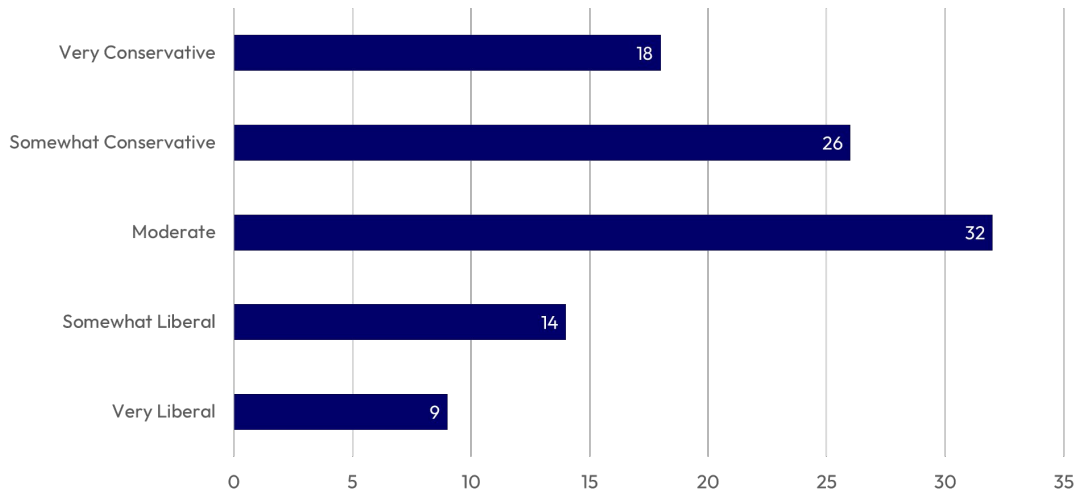
Political Party

Do you consider yourself to be a Republican, Democrat, Independent, or something else?



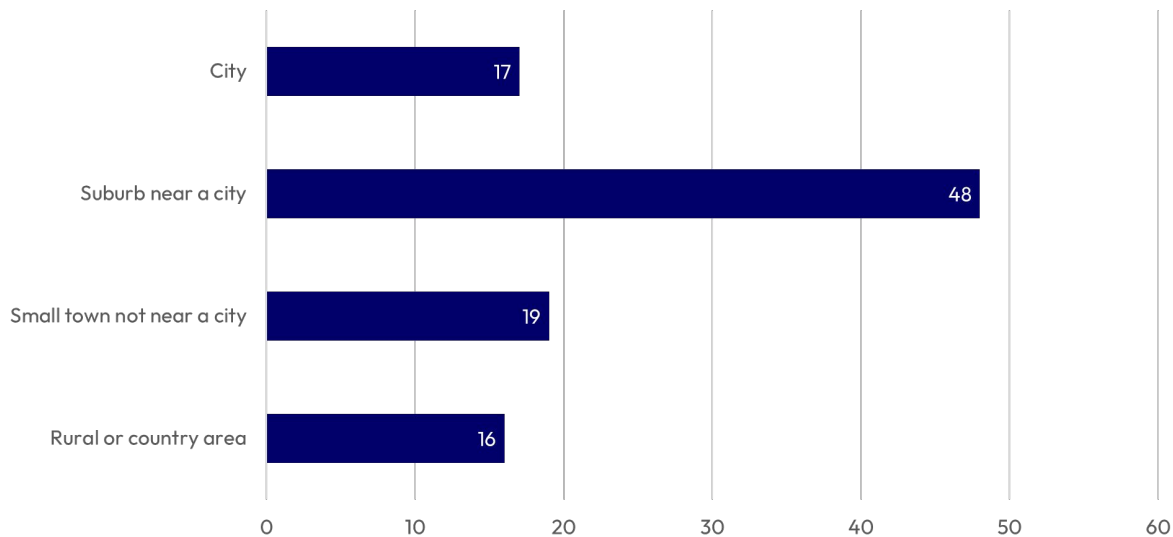
Political Ideology

Do you consider yourself to be Very Conservative, Somewhat Conservative, Moderate, Somewhat Liberal or Very Liberal?



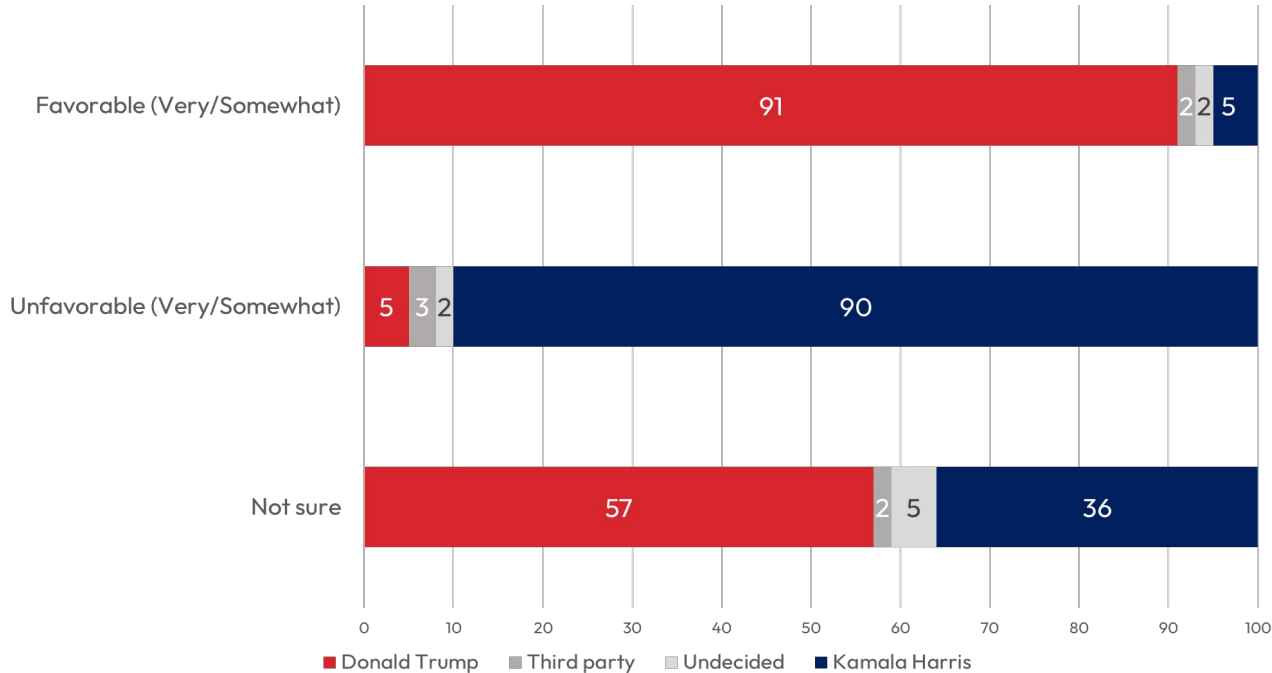

Over 2x too many postgraduate voters were entering the survey prior to controlling for the problem... and at the same time, party identification looked great.
